Words for Meditation: Our help is in the name of the Lord who made heaven and earth.

Call to Worship: 2 Corinthians 1:3-5

Silent Meditation

Silent Meditation

Prayer: God, who is with us, in this season of looking forward, of anticipating the celebration of your Son's birth and return in glory, hear our prayer. We often find ourselves uncomfortable, uneasy, worried, and sad. Liturgy of Remembering - Light a candle for your loved ones

Light the first candle

L: The first candle we light is to remember those whom we have loved and lost. We pause to remember their names, their faces, their voices, and the memories that binds them to us in this season.

Light second candle

L: The second candle we light is to redeem the pain of loss, the loss of someone who was very important to us, part of our lives, part of our own selves. We pause to gather up the pain of the past, including the losses from covid, and offer it to God, asking that from God's hands we receive the gift of peace.

Light third candle

L: The third candle we light is to remember ourselves this Christmas time. We pause and remember these past weeks and months, the disbelief, the anger, the down times, the poignancy of reminiscing, the hugs and handshakes of family and friends, all those who stood with us. We give thanks for all the support we have known.

Light fourth candle

L: The fourth candle is lit to remember our faith and the gift of hope which the Christmas story offers to us. We remember that God, who shares our life, promises us a place and time of no more pain and suffering.

All: Let us look to Jesus-Emmanuel, the One Who shows the way, who brings the truth, who bears the light, and who can bring us peace.
